1. Commitment to EDI in Better Sleep

- Continue building a diverse network of public partners.
- Strengthen relationships with underserved communities, such as the Muslim Women's group via the Asian Cultural Centre.
- Monitor demographics of public partners to ensure representation.

3.1 Key achievements for inclusive research practices and PPIEP

- Established the Better Sleep Research Advisory Network (BSRAN) with Public Partner Champions.

- NHS Shift Workers Research Advisory Group contributed to survey design, data interpretation, recruitment strategies, and intervention feedback.
